

ChiNorBC Project Workshop on Emissions inventories and preliminary modelling results

On 15th December 2021, the Workshop on Emissions inventories and preliminary modelling results was held in Beijing and virtually on zoom co-chaired by the Chinese Academy of Environmental Sciences (CRAES) and the Norwegian Environment Agency (NEA) as the main implementing partners of the project. Representatives from the Norwegian Embassy in Beijing, the Norwegian Environment Agency and the Chinese Academy of Environmental Sciences attended the workshop and delivered speeches.

The Chinese Academy of Environmental Sciences and the Norwegian Environment Agency are implementing agencies of the ChiNorBC Project, while Chinese Academy for Environmental Planning, Norwegian Institute on Public Health and Center for International Climate and Environmental Research-Oslo, Norway are the collaborators of the project.

The meeting featured detailed presentations and discussions on the project overview, Chinese /Norwegian/European control measures, construction of black and organic carbon emission inventories for ChiNorBC project, regional/global model performance evaluation, and health impacts of BC/OC.

At the workshop, the project team and experts had an in-depth exchange on the above. Experts from Peking University commented on the results of the emission inventory of the ChiNorBC Project, and affirmed the scientific rationality of the research methods, ideas and technical approaches of the emission inventory based on the ChiNorBC project, as well as the importance of motor vehicle and domestic emission sources. The meeting helped to strengthen the links and cooperation between the various outputs of the project to ensure the smooth implementation of the project's research work and to further deepen Sino-Norwegian cooperation in the environmental field.
